FIREFIGHTING A new version of the SpiroGuide has now been released. This new improved version has the SpiroGuide Breathing Apparatus Computer (BAC) placed between the back plate and the cylinder. This is the optimal position for protection and low profile. The regulator is mounted onto the back plate and hence this version is referred to as the "Fixed Regulator version".

This new version replaces the previous version, "Floating Regulator version". The new design also includes a new ergonomic hand wheel for the cylinder connection.

» IS-MIX Delivered to the Danish Navy

DIVING In December INTERSPIRO delivered the very first batch of the new rebreather system "IS-MIX" to the Royal Danish Navy.

The IS-MIX is a demand controlled semi-closed breathing system for military use. The IS-MIX has a very low magnetic profile and a very low acoustic signature, both which are essential elements when developing breathing apparatuses for mine clearance operations.

» DP1 and MKII Delivered to US Navy

DIVING Following two years of extensive testing and evaluation by the U.S. Navy Experimental Diving Unit (NEDU) the first batch of INTERSPIRO's light weight Divator DP1/MKII SCUBA surface supply systems were delivered to the U.S. Navy on December 12th.

In addition to the thorough testing and evaluation process, field tests of the equipment were performed on various locations around the world by the U.S. Navy.

Additionally, the United States Army has purchased several INTERSPIRO dive systems and training on these was conducted for deployed troops overseas during December 2008.
